

## About eSwatini (formerly Swaziland)

eSwatini is a small, landlocked kingdom in Southern Africa with a population of just over a million people, and the last remaining absolute monarchy in Africa. The society is polygamous.



At 27%, eSwatini has the highest HIV/AIDS prevalence rate in the world. With 55% of the population under 18 years of age and 67% of the population living below the poverty line, a new generation lives on the brink with children heading households and grannies struggling to keep them alive.

eSwatini's climate is temperate, and winter days have a temperature range of 71° - 74° high and 51° - 52° F lows.
