# WHAT

INTSABA is a God-inspired Village of Hope. It will provide safe housing for 250 orphans and vulnerable children, as well as health care, a quality education, opportunity to develop their skills and abilities and empowerment to reach their full potential.

It will be eco-friendly, using renewable energy, maintaining its pristine environment, featuring farm-to-table freshness in nutrition and unspoiled natural beauty for village occupants and visitors.

# WHY

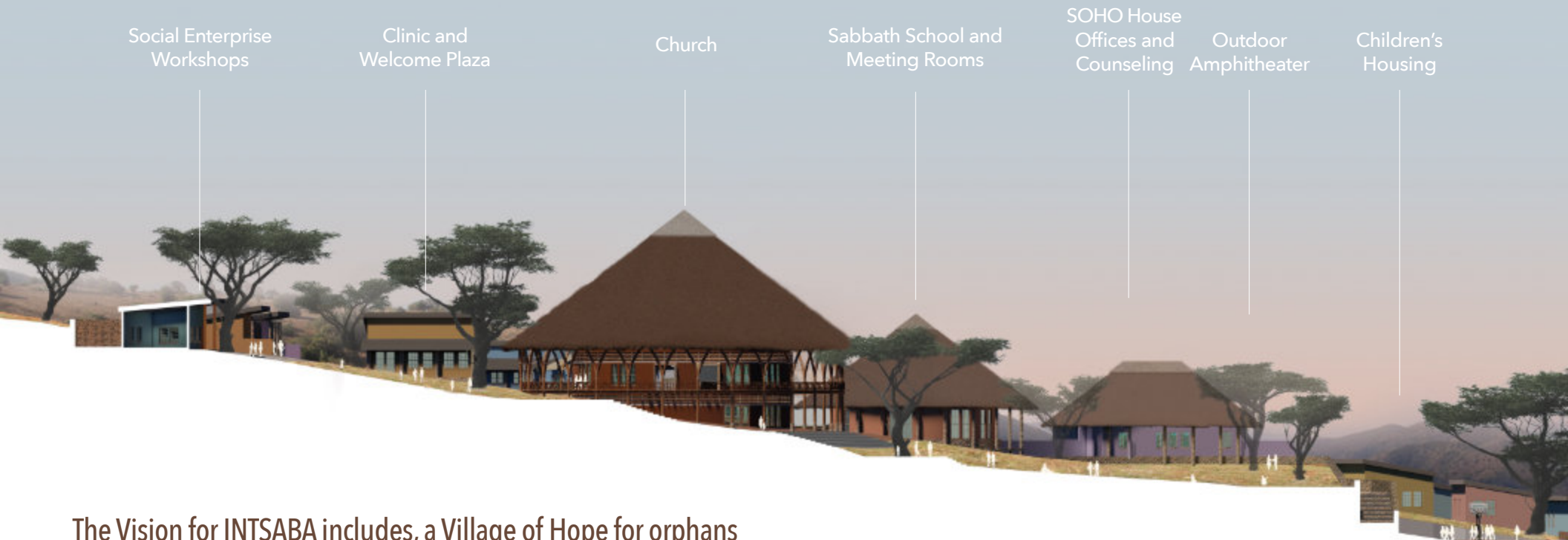
In the wake of the HIV/AIDS pandemic that took the lives of thousands of parents, eSwatini (formerly Swaziland) has a population of over 120,000 orphans and vulnerable children, with 10 to 15% of households headed by them.

Child-headed households are susceptible to abuse and exploitation. Malnutrition is a common problem. With girls heading most child-led households, one in three face sexual abuse. The traditional safety nets are not in place as older women face care of growing numbers of orphans they cannot support.



**INTSABA**  
Children's Village will house, school, feed, nurture and empower a new generation of hope seekers' to become Godly leaders among their peers and in their communities.

# HOW



The Vision for INTSABA includes, a Village of Hope for orphans and vulnerable children. The campus will provide:

- Safe housing
- Trained Care Givers
- Quality Christian education
- An Empowerment Center with access to science, technology , innovative Math learning, the Arts .
- Skills training, and more.

INTSABA will also include income generating projects to build sustainability including:

- A Crafts Center
- Social enterprises such as soap making, nut butter etc.
- A Retreat Center with accommodation for individuals, business and church events and families.



# HOUSING

Before the farm was available, funds were collected to build small houses on tribal land to help protect children at risk. With the blessing of INTSABA, the houses will now be built in the children's village.

Donors who contributed \$10,000 toward a house will be able to experience the satisfaction of seeing the first structures developed and the first children served. Updates will be provided regularly.





# HAPPENING NOW

As schools closed due to Covid restriction in Eswatini, 2020 found hundreds of orphans and vulnerable children starving since their daily meal which the schools provided was no longer available.

Sean Hayter, with a team of farm hands has been working under the supervision of Dr Thomas Chittick, retired Dean of Agriculture from Andrews University, to grow food that has been feeding hundreds of children from the community.

Extensive work has been done at the macadamia orchard including installation of an irrigation system. Five hundred macadamia nut trees were recently donated and are being planted

In spite of broken machinery and Covid 19 disruption, the mile long road that was greatly needed for safety sake as well as for efficiency, is almost complete.

Drawings for Children's Homes and staff housing have been done by Andrew's University School of Architecture and Interior Design in collaboration with Limkokwing University, Swaziland.

Funds are being raised to launch the Agriculture Program so that it can be sustainable, as well as for the first homes for children to be housed. The farm will provide food for the Children's Village as well as grow crops and engage in various Agribusiness enterprises to generate revenue and provide skills training.





# URGENT

Covid 19 has intensified the need to get the Agriculture program and homes for the children . We want to establish storage for produce, and acquire a tractor. We also want to build the first two pods of homes, with each one having three houses.

## \$100,000

A \$100,000 match to jump start the agriculture program and children's housing.

Donations totaling **\$100,000** will be matched dollar for dollar.

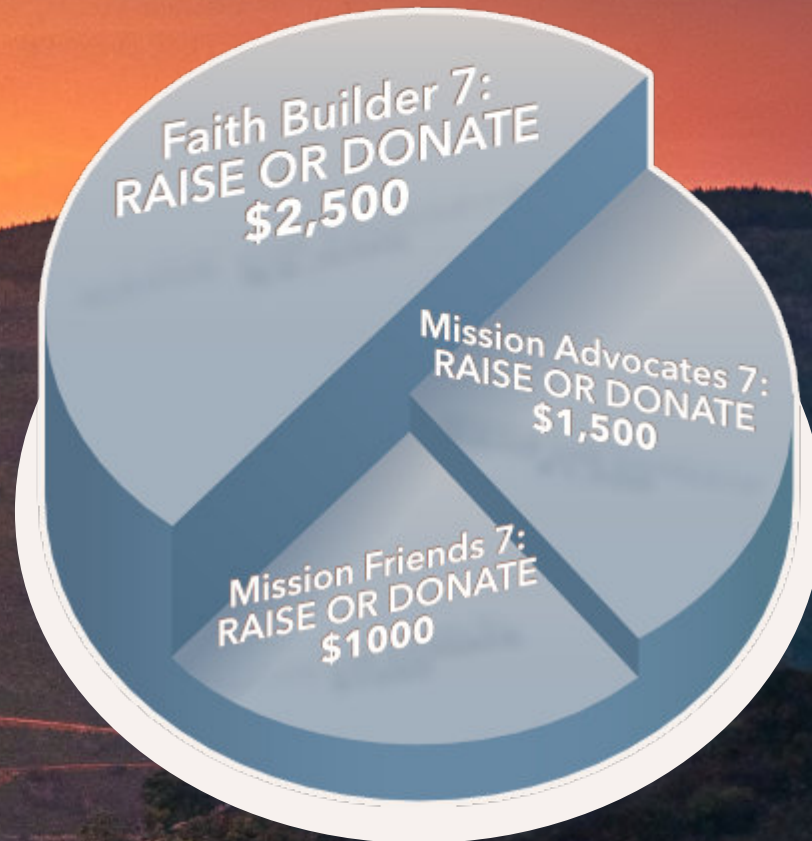
